It is normal for children to behave in ways that are challenging for parents. All children are different and their behaviour relates to their developmental level, temperament, life experiences and environmental factors. This session aims to give parents skills to manage unwanted behaviour through positive behaviour guidance and to reduce parental stress.

Topics include:

- Understanding some of the causes of challenging behaviour
- Skills to help you manage your child's behaviour including rules and basic behaviour management strategies
- Understanding the behaviour escalation cycle
- Understanding what may be maintaining challenging behaviour
